

What is Wisconsin Ice Volleyball Club?

Wisconsin Ice VBC is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization dedicated to raising the level of volleyball skills in the Central Wisconsin area in a competitive, fun environment. If you love to play the game or have the desire to be the best player you can be, then Wisconsin Ice Volleyball Club is for you! The Club is part of the Badger Region Volleyball Association, which is Wisconsin's governing body for youth volleyball players. Badger Region endorses, supports, regulates and controls volleyball in the Junior Olympic Volleyball arm of USA Volleyball. Check out our website for the latest information! www.wisconsinice.net

What kind of teams will be offered?

Wisconsin Ice VBC will be offering girls' Purple, Black & White level teams; Ice Chips & Ice Shavings; and boys' 10s-15s & 16s-18s programs as described in the next column (see our website, www.wisconsinice.net, for more information).

Who coaches the teams?

All coaches who work within the auspices of Badger Region Volleyball are required to be certified through the process mandated by USA Volleyball. Coaches may have been players in college or may be adults with a volleyball background who wish to work with young players on their volleyball skills. We have a very talented, qualified & accomplished core of experienced volleyball coaches.

When are tournaments?

Tournaments are normally on Sunday, but may be on Saturday. Purple Black & White teams will be assigned to approximately 8 to 11 play dates based on the age level and type of team. Ice Chips will have 3 to 4 play dates. Boys' 16s-18s will have 2-3 tournaments & Boys' 10s-15s might have 1-2 tournaments.

Membership Fees?

Membership fees for the **PURPLE, BLACK & WHITE** level teams and the Boys' **FIRE** teams will be established before the beginning of the 2011 season & will be announced at the Informational Meeting on October 24, 2010. Fees are due in full before the 1st practice. Payment plans are available. Membership fees of \$295 for **ICE CHIPS** & \$55 for **ICE SHAVINGS** are the same as last season. These fees are due at the 1st practice.

New This Year!

GIRLS' 13-18s PROGRAMS

Wisconsin Ice has restructured the team offerings to include 3 teams in most age divisions: Purple, Black & White. Teams are ability based with members selected based both on skill level and positions needed as determined during the "tryouts & skills assessment" process.

Season begins with tryouts on 11/13 & 14/10 and ends in late April. Practices will be 2 times per week with a 3rd optional positional practice in December, except on tournament weekends the weekend practice will be eliminated. Tournaments begin in January and end in mid to late April.

WISCONSIN ICE "FIRE" BOYS' TEAMS

10s-15s - a developmental program for boys wishing to learn & improve their volleyball skills and to possibly be introduced to tournament play in 1 or 2 tournaments.

16s-18s - a program for players wishing to improve their volleyball skills through instruction & play at practices and a few tournaments.

Length of Season & Practices: Starts with the first practice on 12/05/10 & ends in mid to late March. Practices will be once a week on the weekend, except on tournament weekends the practice will be moved to mid-week. Tournaments will begin in January, at the earliest.

How are members selected? All boys are eligible for these programs and are placed in groups based on skill level & by the availability of coaches. Players may be placed by age & ability if needed.

WISCONSIN "ICE CHIPS"

Teams offered in Wausau area

Definition: For players ages 11 & 12. Chips players will learn volleyball skills, meet new people & have a load of fun, too! Boys are welcome at this level.

Length of Season & Practices: December to early March. Teams will practice 1 to 2 times per week.

WISCONSIN "ICE SHAVINGS"

Teams offered in Wausau & Stevens Point areas

Definition: Pre-tournament teams for players who are ages 8-10. Shavings players will be introduced to volleyball skills & will meet new people in a fun environment. Boys are welcome at this level.

Length of Season & Practices: December to early March. Teams will practice 1 time per week.

Directions to Informational Meeting, Tryouts & Skills Assessment, & All Call at Wisconsin Valley Lutheran High School

Directions: take I-39/US-51 toward Mosinee; take the Maple Ridge Road exit, EXIT 181; Turn LEFT if heading north on I-39 or RIGHT if heading south on I-39 onto Maple Ridge Road; Continue on Maple Ridge Road, over the railroad tracks until you reach Wisconsin Valley Lutheran High School on the left side of Maple Ridge Road at 601 Maple Ridge Road, Mosinee 54455.

Boys Programs: 10s-15s & 16s-18s – First practice on December 5, 2010. Location & times to be announced at a later date.

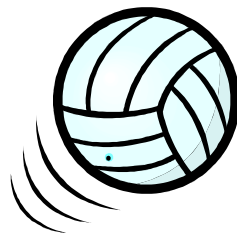

On-line "Web Point" registration must be completed & all forms & check must be in our hands by November 11, 2010, in order to be considered early registration.
